

All Star Selection Process - PLAYERS

1. Players will be placed on the ballot for the division played in for the season. If playing up they will be placed on the younger league age ballot (of the division they are playing in) and their league age appropriate ballot. I.E. a league age 8 child plays up in 10u, they will be placed on the league age 9 ballot for voting purposes.
2. Voting
 - a. Ballots will list players by team and uniform number
 - b. Managers and rostered coaches will vote up to 12 players per age group in their own division. **NOTE: In a baseball division with ≤ 4 teams they will vote up to 6 players per age group.**
 - a. Rostered coaches *by* must be declared to player agent by each team Manager *the second Saturday of the Spring season, to be eligible to vote.*
 - c. Players in 12U and up will vote up to 12 players per age group in their own division. **NOTE: In a baseball division with ≤ 4 teams they will vote up to 6 players per age group.**
3. The top 25 (top 35 in a division with > 100 players) vote-getters in each age group will be invited to a try-out
 - a. Attendance is not mandatory
 - b. The approved manager must attend the try-out
 - c. Any coach interested in managing a B team must attend the try-out
 - d. If there are less than ≤ 4 teams in a division there will be no try-out. Step 3 will be skipped.
4. After the try-out is complete, the top 8 vote-getters (from the original vote) will be placed on the All-Star Team. **(Top 4 in a baseball division with ≤ 4 teams)** This will be the first time the manager is given this information.
 - a. **In the case of a tie for player #8, the top 7 players will be placed on the All-Star Team. (Tie for #4, the BB division with 4 or fewer teams, the top 3 will be placed on team)**
 - b. The manager will then select from the eligible (players eligibility is determined per Babe Ruth rule prior to placement on the ballot; a player on the original ballot is eligible) pool of players their remaining players until they reach a roster of 12 – 15 players.
 - c. Teams shall be formed sequentially, highest to lowest
5. If a player turns down the A team, they are not eligible to play for the B team in that same league age group. **All A-teams in a division will be rostered before any B-teams will be considered.**
6. If a player turns down the higher league age team in their division, they are eligible to play for their league age team if selected. I.E. 9 year-old player turns down the 10u team, they are eligible to be selected for the 9u team.
